State Parks is working on a planning project to improve several state parks in South Puget Sound. State Parks manages a considerable collection of land-based and boat access parks, as well as undeveloped properties on south Sound waters. We would like your input on how best to improve facilities and steward park natural and cultural resources in these parks.

Parks in the project area include:

- Kopachuck
- Cutts Island
- Penrose Point
- Joemma Beach
- Haley Property (undeveloped)
- Jarrell Cove
- Stretch Point (on Stretch Island)
- McMicken Island
- Harstine Island
- Hope Island
- Eagle Island

Our planning system includes several stages with opportunities for your input at each stage. The next stage will follow up on comments that park visitors and community members have already provided. You will have the opportunity to provide feedback on several alternative approaches to land use planning in the South Sound State Parks. We have several ways to participate. You can:
